Why A Pre-Purchase Inspection (PPI) Is Non-Negotiable

When you're buying a \$100k-\$300k vehicle, emotion can cloud judgment fast.

You're imagining the drive, the sound, the reactions, but one missed detail can cost more than a year's worth of ownership.

A **Pre-Purchase Inspection (PPI)** is a professional, third-party evaluation that reveals the true condition of the car. It's your *financial X-ray* before committing.

Why it's essential:

- Hidden Issues: Even perfect-looking cars can have \$10k-\$30k worth of problems.
- Negotiation Power: Every issue becomes leverage to lower the price.
- Peace of Mind: Buy with confidence, not guesswork.

While any mechanic can look for basic issues, we recommend you to find third party shops that are experienced in a specific make or model.

Meaning... don't have a Toyota mechanic inspect a BMW.

Not only do they lack the knowledge, many shops lack the proprietary tools to read vehicle control units like the engine or transmission.

This is where logs and important data can be accessed that shows more than the surface.

If for any reason you can't locate a nearby shop local to the car you're looking at, a dealership is still OK.

Sometimes scheduling a PPI can be difficult if a dealer is not willing to drive or transport the vehicle offsite to a mechanic.

I can't tell you how many times I've skipped purchasing a car because of the lack of a PPI.

While there are companies like Lemon Squad, they too lack the experience and tools needed to perform a thorough inspection.

Skipping a PPI is like buying a house without an inspection. You might get lucky once, but eventually, it'll cost you dearly.

While there is a cost associated with Pre-Purchase Inspections, it usually is around \$150-\$1,000 depending on where you go and what's entailed.

But rest assured this small investment could provide the biggest return on investment when it comes to purchasing a luxury or exotic car.

And yes, even if a car is like-new, under factory warranty, or certified pre-owned, you still want to get a PPI.



Most independent shops will offer PPIs based on the mechanical aspect of a car.

Some shops will also go above and beyond and look at body panels for chips, curb rash, damage, or paint work using tools like paint meters for inconsistencies between panels.



The 6-Step Inspection Framework

The more thorough the inspection, the better your odds are of buying a car that will become a headache down the road.

There are 6 different steps we recommend to ensure you're not buying a lemon and one that separates *profitable cars* from *financial disasters*.

Here are some general items to look for and request for any kind of Pre-Purchase Inspection

1. Initial Visual Check:

- a. Panel gap misalignment (indicate replacement)
- b. Paint work (repairs)
- c. Rock chips or deep scratches
- d. Wheel scuffs and curb rash
- e. Fading clearcoat on trim panels like carbon fiber
- f. Tire age and treadlife
- g. Rust and corrosion under car
- h. Paint protection film installation issues

2. Mechanical Review:

- a. Brake pad and rotors wear or damage
- b. Engine leaks (valve covers, oil filters, rear main seal,e tc)
- c. Leaking struts
- d. Worn or torn bushings
- e. Transmission and differential leaks
- f. Clutch wear reading (if applicable for manual cars)
- g. Mechanical shavings in engine / transmission plugs/filters
- h. Engine compression tests (NOT common but can be done)
- i. Worn engine belts

3. Diagnostic Scans:

- a. Pull codes for stored or active Check Engine Lights
- b. Check over-rev history (especially Porsche)
- c. Verify mileage Odometer fraud is rampant for new Audi, BMW, Mercedes, Lamborghini
- d. See if car has been previously tuned Could indicate excessive engine and transmission stress

4. Interior & Electronics:

- a. Test all switches, seat functions, infotainment controls.
- b. Sticky buttons on older exotics (Ferrari, Maserati, Lambo)
- c. Sagging headliners
- d. Seat rips and tears
- e. Hot/warm air conditioning may need a recharge or sign of larger issue

5. Test Drive:


- a. Feel for vibrations and alignment issues
- b. Excessive brake noise could indicate worn pads/rotors
- c. Rough gear engagement could indicate need for transmission flush

d. Pay attention to unusual noises like grinding, knocking, screeching, etc

6. Documentation Review:

- a. Verify service records (if applicable)
- b. Check title for clear status
- c. Verify VIN matches throughout the car (dash, enginebay, engine, etc.
- d. Run a CarFax/Autocheck for accident and service history
